- 1. The coordinator read out the minutes of the meeting of IQAC held on 23.8.2018. The Minutes were confirmed.
- 2. It was decided to conduct the Alumni Meet and obtain the feedback from them for developing quality culture in the institution. It was also decided to take their help in training the students for cultural programmes, sports and other co-curricular activities.
