The committee devised the following plan of action for the session 2019-2020:

1. Regular meetings of IQAC

The meeting of internal quality assurance cell will be conducted regularly. The IQAC will meet at least once every quarter.

2. Anual Quality Assurance Report

The AQAR of the previous year will be prepared and submitted to the NAAC within the time limit.

3. Feedback from stakeholders

Feedback from students, teachers, parents and alumni will be collected, analysed and utilised for quality enhancement.

4. Student Satisfaction Survey

Student Satisfaction Survey will be conducted, analysed and utilised for quality enhancement and sustenance.

5. Optimization and integration of modern methods of teaching and learning

Innovative modern teaching-learning methods will be used for making the process of teaching-learning participative and student-centric. The use of ICT will be promoted. More emphasis will be laid on experiential learning. Students of the Department of History will be given tours of the places of historical importance.

6. Monitoring of Classes

A monitoring committee will be formed to monitor the classes. The committee will comprise of senior professors of all the faculties.

7. SWOC Analysis

SWOC analysis of the institution will be done to find out the strength, weaknesses, opportunities and challenges. Quality enhancement initiatives will be taken on the basis of the analysis.

8. Infrastructure Augmentation

Keeping in view the rise in the strength of students, four class rooms are being constructed through the scheme of RUSA. Attempts will be made to get more class rooms constructed. Equipment and instruments for science laboratories will also be purchased.

9. Induction Programme

Induction programme will be conducted for the newly admitted students to inform them about the courses, infrastructure, student welfare schemes, study centre, amenities etc. available in the institution.

10. Co-curricular Activities

Students will be motivated to participate and give their best in curricular as well as cocurricular activities.

11. National/International Commemorative Days/ Events

National/International commemorative days like world yoga day, Sadbhavana Diwas, Gandhi Jayanti, NSS Day, Earth Day, World AIDS Day, World Youth Day, Independence Day, NSS Day, Madhya Pradesh Sthapna (foundation) Diwas, World Human Rights Day, Vivekananda Jayanti, Votes Day, Republic Day, Martyrs Day etc. will be celebrated/organised.

12. J.H. e-News

In order to disseminate the information regarding various activities related to quality enhancement and sustenance to all the stake holders, JH e-News will continue to be published.

13. Promotion of Universal Values

In order to promote universal values amongst the students, activities like workshops, seminars, group discussions and guest lectures will be conducted.

14. Voters Awareness Activities

Activities like essay writing, slogan writing, debate, rangoli, *nukkad natak* (street plays) quiz. etc. will be conducted under the SVEEP (Systematic Voters Education Electoral Participation) programme.

15. Community Welfare Activities

Community welfare activities will be conducted through NSS and NCC.

16. Eco-Friendly Campus

Initiatives will be taken to make the campus eco-friendly. Faculty members, students and non-teaching staff will be motivated to participate in plantation drives. The use of plastic, tobacco smoking and chewing of pan-masalas will be completely banned in the campus. Incandescent light bulbs will be replaced with LEDs.

Students will be encouraged to spread awareness regarding environment pollution during the NSS camps.

17. Career Fair

District level career fair will be held in the institution where local companies as well as companies / organisations from the surrounding areas will be invited to provide job-oriented training or job opportunities to the students.

Item No 1

Item No 2

Distribution of the work for the preparation of AQAR for the session 2018-19

The work related to the preparation of AQAR was distributed amongst the professors working as the members of IQAC. It was decided that the information related to various criteria will be collected from all the departments within fifteen days.

Item No 3

Updation of the institutional website

It was decided that the website of the institution will be updated. A separate committee will be constituted for the purpose.

An exclusive window tab will be created on institutional website for keeping the records/files of NAAC, Peer Team Reports, AQARs and certificates of accreditation outcomes. The bio-data of the professors, reports on the activities of various committees as well as of departments will be collected for uploading on the website. The soft copies of the question papers of the previous five years' examinations will be collected from all the departments to be uploaded on the website.

Item No 4

Analysis of Student Satisfaction Survey and Feedback

Students Satisfaction Survey was done through the World Bank a few months ago. It was decided that the proformas of the survey will be collected from all the department. The data received will be analysed.

The feedback taken from the students, teachers, alumni, parents and other stakeholders will also be analysed and necessary action will be taken for the enhancement of the quality culture of the institution.

Item No 5

Use of ICT in teaching and learning

All the newly appointed teachers will be instructed to prepare the PPTs as teaching material. The same PPTs will be saved in the computers of their departments to be used as teaching material. Senior professors will be instructed to prepare their study materials for NPTEL.

Item No 6

All the professors will be motivated to publish their research papers in UGC approved journals, to present their research papers in national and international journals and to get MRPs from UGC.

Item No 8

Item No 9

Attempts will be made to motivate the students to do short-term certificate courses through SWAYAM (Study Webs of Active Learning for Young Aspiring Mind) portal of UGC.

Item No 10

Item No 11
