Action Taken and Outcome Achieved Session 2019-2020

- The meetings of internal quality assurance committee were held regularly.
- The AQAR of the previous year was prepared.
- Feedback from students, teachers, parents and alumni was collected, analysed and utilised for quality enhancement .
- Student Satisfaction Survey was conducted, analysed and utilised for quality enhancement and sustenance.
- Innovative modern teaching- learning methods were used for making the process of teaching - learning participative and student - centric. The use of ICT was promoted. More emphasis was laid on experiential learning. The students of the Department of History were taken to the places of historical importance. Online classes were conducted during the lockdown period.
- A monitoring committee comprising of some of the senior faculty members was formed to monitor the classes.
- SWOC Analysis of the institution was done to find out the strength, weaknesses, opportunities and challenges of the institution. Quality enhancement initiatives were taken on the basis of the analysis.
- Keeping in view the growth in the enrolment of the students, four class rooms were constructed through the scheme of RUSA. Equipment and instruments for science laboratories were also purchased.
- Induction programme was conducted for the newly admitted students to inform them about the courses, infrastructure, student welfare schemes and amenities available in the institution.

- National/International commemorative days like World Yoga Day, *Sadbhavana Diwas*, Gandhi Jayanti, NSS Day, Earth Day, World AIDS Day, World Youth Day, Independence Day, NSS Day, Madhya Pradesh *Sthapna* (Foundation) Diwas, World Human Rights Day, Vivekananda Jayanti, Votes Day, Republic Day, Martyrs' Day were celebrated/ organised.
- In order to disseminate the information regarding various activities related to quality enhancement and sustenance to all the stake holders, J H e-News was published.
- In order to promote universal values amongst the student, activities like workshops, seminars, group discussion and guest lectures were conducted.

- Activities like essay writing, slogan writing, debate, rangoli, *mukkad natak* (street plays) quiz. etc. were conducted under the SVEEP (Systematic Voters Education Electoral Participation) programme.

Action Taken and Outcome Achieved Session 2020-2021


- A one day national webinar on 'The Impact of COVID-19 Pandemic on Rural Students in Higher Education' was conducted by IQAC on 7th July, 2020.

Action Taken Report 2021-2022

- Twenty seminars and webinars on the topics such as Intellectual Property Rights, Research Methodology, Gender Equity were organised.
- Nine MOUs were signed with other institutions and organisations to conduct collaborative academic and co-curricular activities.
